Job Description: Design Manager

My most significant role to date was Design Manager at mobile accessories brand Juice Global Ltd, where I worked for 5 years, leading the creative media & artwork for an award-winning range of products made from recycled plastic, the "Made Mindfully" campaign.

I led a 4-person team in producing all the visual content, packaging, POS & marketing materials for the business, as well as new product R&D and managing of e-commerce. Prior to this management role, I was the senior designer working under a marketing manager. My time at Juice brought my acquired skills together into a demanding multi-faceted role in which I helped produce and oversee a visual evolution of the branding and packaging.

#### This specifically entailed:

My role as design manager was to organise my team and utilise our skillsets to produce the most progressive, interesting and visually attractive work we could – all with the goal of elevating the brand. Along with my management responsibilities, I was also solely responsible for producing and updating all product artwork across the range of 100-150 products, as well as handling various e-commerce tasks.

My career at Juice started chaotically at the beginning of the pandemic – we were all sent to work from home on my first day! This challenging situation required all of my previous experience as I was thrust into the thick of it as part of a three-person team – two designers and our Marketing & Design Manager. My initial responsibilities were:

- To create digital & video content for our social channels and mailing list, including GIFs and animation
- Produce presentations for new business and new product showcases, set to a provided brief
- · Create packaging visuals and display unit planograms for retailers and potential customers
- Visualise and conceive new ideas for packaging and product ranges for the brand, including photographic editing, bringing the packaging from artwork concept right through to samples and production.

After a successful & intense first year in a reduced team, I progressed to senior designer, where my responsibilities grew to handling all new and existing artwork on live order and guiding our junior designer. At this point I also took a course in Cinema 4D to elevate my work with 3D visualisation for packaging, product, POS, above the line campaigns and hero imagery.

From June '22 I managed the team, where I created briefs, managed projects and workflow, and answered to the CEO directly, on top of my existing responsibilities.

I took the decision to leave Juice in March for a Senior Project Management role with the creative marketing agency, CAB Studios. This role has helped me build on the project management skills I had developed while at Juice, with the same level of involvement in the design process, but less emphasis on the designing itself.

Unfortunately for me, the decision was taken to close the Property arm of the studio, leaving my position redundant.

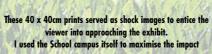


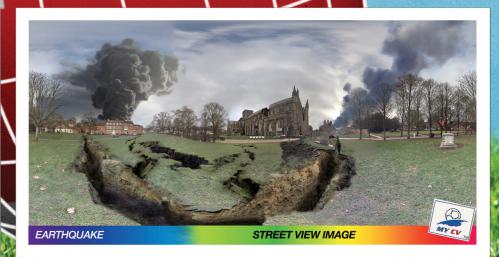
I took 360° photos on the google streetview app and exported them to a 2D state. I then used Photoshop to incorporate scenes of destruction and natural disaster into familiar areas of Winchester and re-exported the files to 360° format, placing the viewer in the centre of the chaos











Using the same technique of comping-in disaster photos, I manipulated 360° images I took of Winchester Cathedral and the City Centre. The challenge differed in that I had to take into account the warping that occurs in a flat layout of a 360° image

For much of the design and production of this project, I used more traditional and analogue mehtods of stamp carving and Riso print production



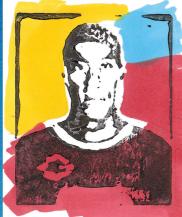

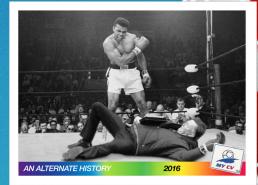


To celebrate the 2018 World Cup, I produced a series of edits combining friends with the Panini stickers of World Cup legends throughout the years

As part of my ongoing "alternate history" collection, I marked Luis Van Gaal's classic 'simulation' moment by changing the course of history forever



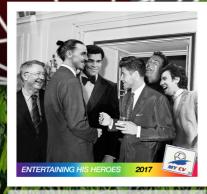
This collage combines Man United players & coaches from various stages of the Premier League era to form an "ultimate squad - created for my brother's birthday

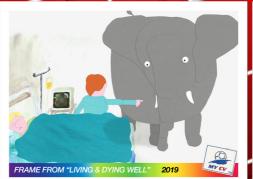

A look into perceived cultural differences, the startling technological advancement of the last 20 years & the hypocrisy between generations, set in a satirical Britain

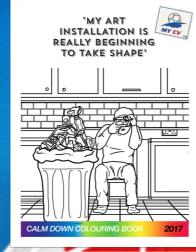

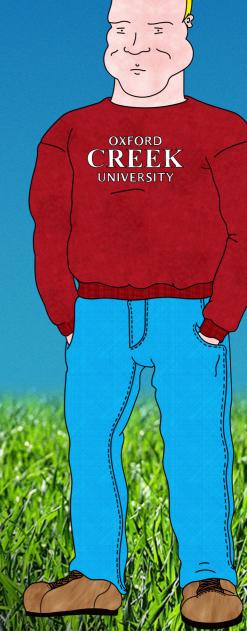


Editorial Illustration concept for a year 2 project
